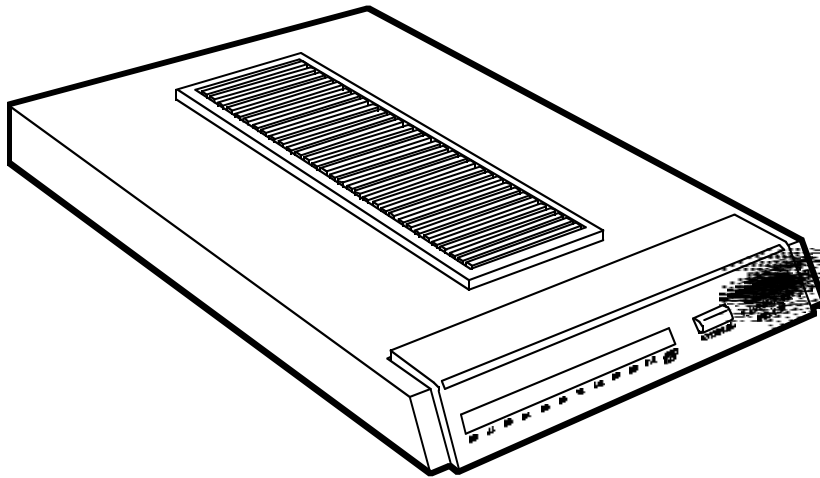

Microsoft plug-and-play support automatically senses the modem type and configures it appropriately

using Windows® 95 or Windows NT.

The modem can use Caller ID from your phone company to tell you the date, time, originating number, and directory listing name for every call.

If you subscribe to Distinctive Ring Service, the modem will recognize and route four ring patterns. Let answering machines, fax machines, modems, and telephones share a single access point.

Carrier-loss redial saves time and increases productivity by automatically redialing the last number when the carrier is lost.

Typical Application

Telecommute from home or a local office over a 56K leased line to download data and files from a computer in a remote office.

Technically Speaking

V.90 and the Internet

Internet service providers and on-line services invariably provide V.90 as the connection standard. You can download information nearly twice as fast as with ordinary V.34 modems, so you reduce waiting time.

V.90 for Corporations

Corporations can improve remote access and performance with V.90, matching the speed yet avoiding the expense and hassle of installing special ISDN lines. Modems with V.90 speed up the delivery of information, so end users gain in productivity when accessing databases, corporate Intranets, e-mail, and specialised applications such as medical imaging. Note that a digital connection to a central office is required at one end of the link.
