


2-Port CAT5 USB 2.0 Extender w/Local Power Quick Start Guide

Break the 16-foot (5-m) USB distance barrier. This local transmitter/remote receiver pair extends USB up to 328 feet (100 meters) from a computer over CAT5 cabling.

Before you get started, make sure that all the drivers required for your USB device(s) are installed.

1. Place the units where you want them and connect the CAT5 cabling to the Link ports (RJ-45) on the local and remote units.





2. Connect the local unit to the AC adapter.




3. Connect the local unit to the computer.
