
#### Installation:

## NOTE

The fan can be mounted at either the top or bottom of the cabinet. The fan can draw outside air into the cabinet *or* exhaust air from inside the cabinet, depending on how the fan is installed. Note the airflow-direction arrow on the side of fan during installation.

- 1) Remove the cover plate from the end of cabinet where the fan will be mounted.
- 2) Install a nut clip over the mounting holes in the fan body. Install it with the smooth face of the nut clip to the outside of the fan body. Repeat for the remaining 3 nut clips.
- 3) Attach a finger guard to the side of the fan that will be exposed on the inside of the cabinet after installation. Attach it with 2 screws and 2 lockwashers. The screws will go into the nut clips attached to the fan in the previous step.
- 4) Place the remaining finger guard on the outside of the cabinet and place the fan on the inside of the cabinet, aligning the holes in the fan, cabinet, and finger guard. Attach it with 2 screws and 2 lockwashers into the nut clips on the fan.
- 5) Attach the power cord by aligning the power lugs on the fan body with the slots on the end of the power cord. Press the plug firmly against the fan body to assure electrical connection.
