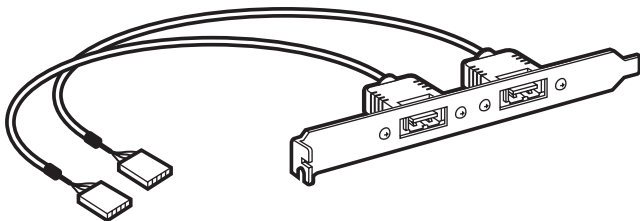

Introduction

The USB Expansion Port lets you use two ports on one bracket, thus minimizing the amount of space used on your workstation. The Port is Windows® 95, Windows NT™, and Windows 98 driven, so additional software is not needed—just plug and play!

Installation

1. Unplug your computer.
2. Remove your computer's shell or cover.
3. Screw the bracket into an open slot on your computer.
4. Plug your bracket's 5-pin USB connector onto the USB pins provided on your computer's motherboard (see the top illustration on the next page).
5. Place your computer's shell or cover back on to your computer. The 2 exposed jacks are for "A" type USB connectors. (See the bottom illustration on the next page.)
6. Plug in your computer.
7. Turn on your computer. Installation is complete.
